Boris Johnson has vowed to work "side-by-side" with the DUP in the autumn if he becomes Britain's next prime minister. Mr Johnson, who serves as Foreign Secretary in a cabinet led by Jeremy Hunt, has placed himself firmly at the heart of the Conservative Party's Brexit policy and has declared that he would be best placed to navigate Brexit talks with the EU. The Tory leadership candidate is the UK's most prominent Leave campaigner, who has sent a number of signals to Tory Leave supporters that he is prepared to defy pressure from hardline Brexiteers within his party.
